Requirements:

- Successful completion of Associate degree from a recognized institution.
- The entry point (according to Framework for Higher Education Qualifications in England) for students shall be level 5. This means a student would complete an Associate degree then study year 2 and year 3 with Middlesex. Upon successful completion the student would be awarded with a full Bachelor's degree. Generally, a student completes 2 years at a US institution and 2 years in the UK to complete their undergraduate studies.
- Students must achieve GPA of at least 3.0.
